



# DAVID COX RESEARCH PRIZE NOMINATION

## For Award in 2024

### Criteria

- The David Cox Research Prize is awarded annually to a fellow of the Society near the beginning of their research career for an outstanding published contribution to statistical theory or application.
- The Prize has a limit in terms of the number of years since the award of a PhD. This limit applies to the year in which

the RSS award is made, not to the year of nomination, and to the year in which the PhD was completed, not to the date of formal graduation.

- Eligible candidates must be within four years of the award of their PhD. Additional allowance may be made for known career breaks.
