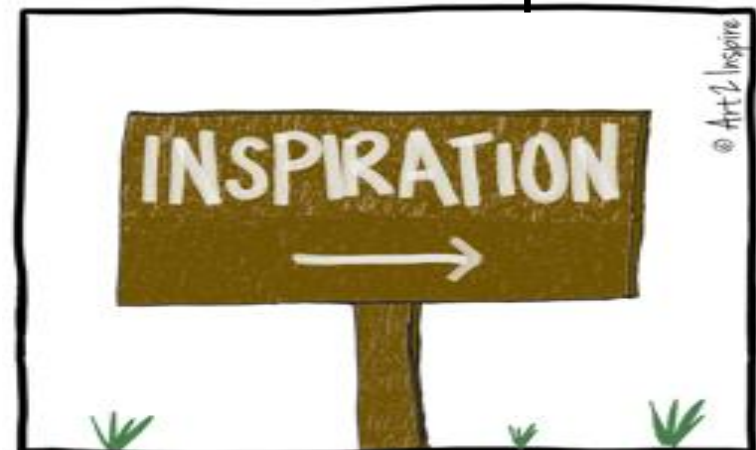
# FOCUS & MOTIVATION
