Background

- **Survey of professional members (CSTAT, GradStat, MIS/FIS) carried out 4Q 2011**
- **Survey: Aims**
 - Understand extent to which existing services were being utilized
 - **Investigate level of support for a Professional Statisticians Forum**
- **PSF: Aims**
 - Regular meetings by, and for, Professional Statistician members of RSS
 - Statisticians, Statistical Consultants, Group Leaders
 - Industry, commerce, government, research orgs, academia
 - Discuss issues of interest to the profession as a whole
 - Topics not adequately covered elsewhere in the RSS
 - Provide a forum for networking

Survey

- **~1700 professional members surveyed**
- **>600 responded, among whom:**
 - 74% CSTATS, 21% GradStats
 - 56% had >20yrs experience
- **RSS Professional Affairs Committee felt there was sufficient support to initiate a PSF**
 - 56% interested to attend PSF events

PSF: Top 10 topics suggested by survey respondents

- **Ethical issues encountered by practicing statisticians**
- **CPD: how to make it effective**
- **The challenges of consultancy and how to make a success of it**
- **Sharing learning/experiences across employment sectors**
- **Recruitment and retention of statisticians: issues and successes**
- **How can we enhance the value of the CStat award?**
- **How should the RSS work with employers to best support professional statisticians?**
- **Issues in leading a statistical group**
- **Career planning**
- **Creating a mentoring culture in the profession**

PSF: programme in year 1

- **PSF events open to professional statistician members of RSS only**
 - 1 session at Conference
 - 1 meeting at Errol Street
 - 1 virtual event

- **In future, PSF programme may include**
 - Joint meetings with RSS sections, local groups or AAAG
 - Open to participants of the partnering group as well as professional members

PSF: practicalities

- **Co-ordinating committee to be established**
 - Small, say, n=3 – 4
 - Looking for members now!
- **Chaired by a member of Professional Affairs Committee**
- **Responsible for:**
 - Creating programme of events (3-4 / year)
 - Identifying event organisers
- **Event format**
 - 1 event face-to-face
 - Other events virtual (phone / web)
