



GUY MEDAL IN BRONZE NOMINATION

For Award in 2024

Criteria

- The Guy Medal in Bronze is awarded to a fellow of the Society in respect of excellent work presented to any conference or meeting run by the Society or published in any of the Society's journals.
- Eligible candidates must be within fifteen years of the award of their first degree. Additional allowance may be made for known career breaks. If the first degree is at Master's level, the time limit is reduced by one year. Other contributions to statistics may be considered.
- If a candidate's work published in the Society's journals (or presented at a Society conference or meeting) is jointly authored, the Honours Committee would, similarly, need to be satisfied that a candidate has sufficient merit in their own right for the award.
