## For Award in 2024

## Criteria

- The Guy Medal in Silver is awarded to a fellow of the Society in respect of a paper or papers of special merit communicated to the Society at its discussion meetings (formerly known as ordinary meetings). Other contributions to statistics may also be considered.
- Because the award is made to an individual, in the case
  of joint authorship of a paper the Honours Committee
  would need to be satisfied that a candidate has sufficient
  merit in their own right for the award, for example based
  on other published research work or of clear contribution
  to the paper in question. (It is therefore acceptable for
  the case to include a jointly authored paper cited in a
  previous award to another author.)
